09:30 Departure from the Hotel Grand Tarabya

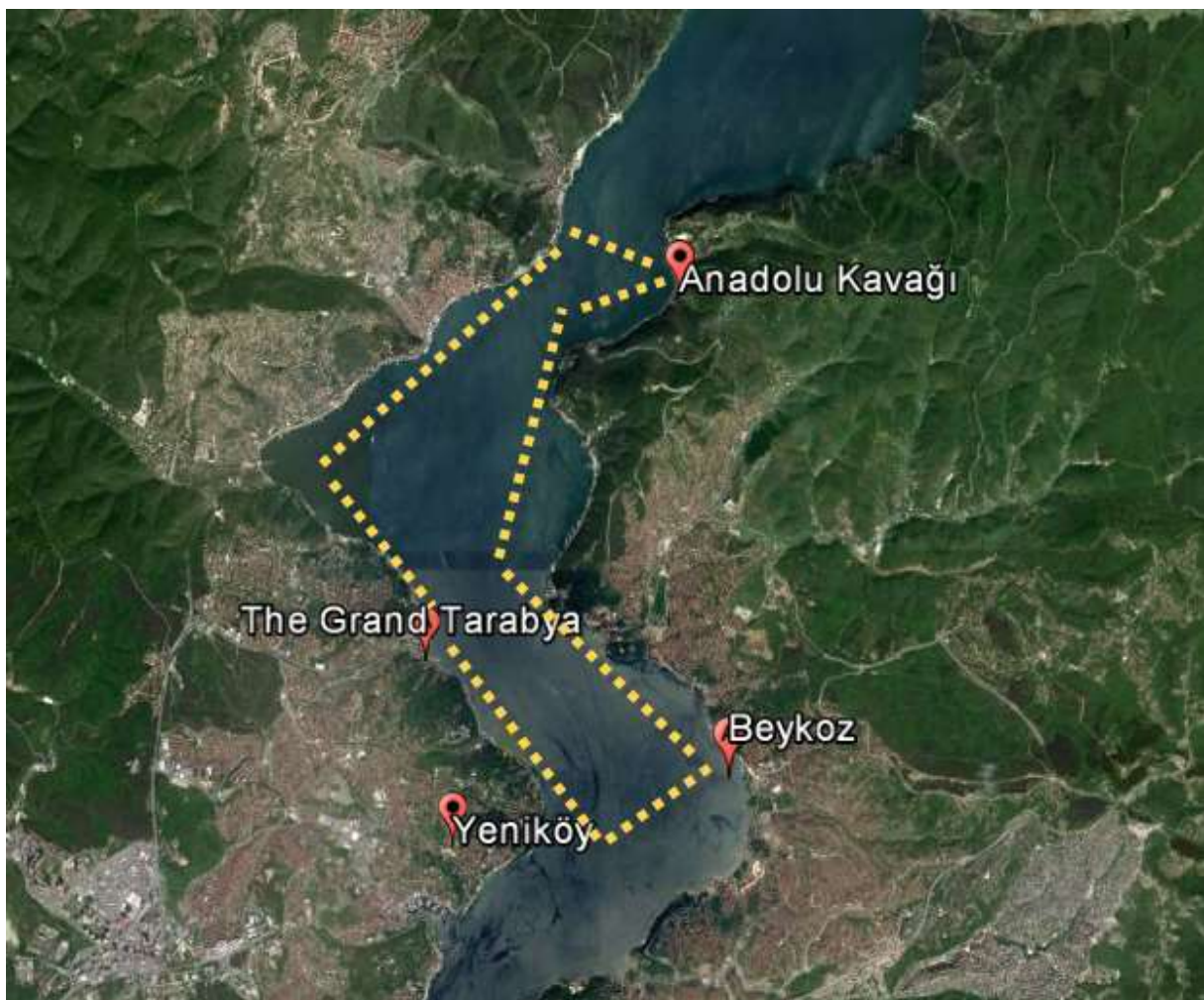

Tour 2 Discover of Other Istanbul

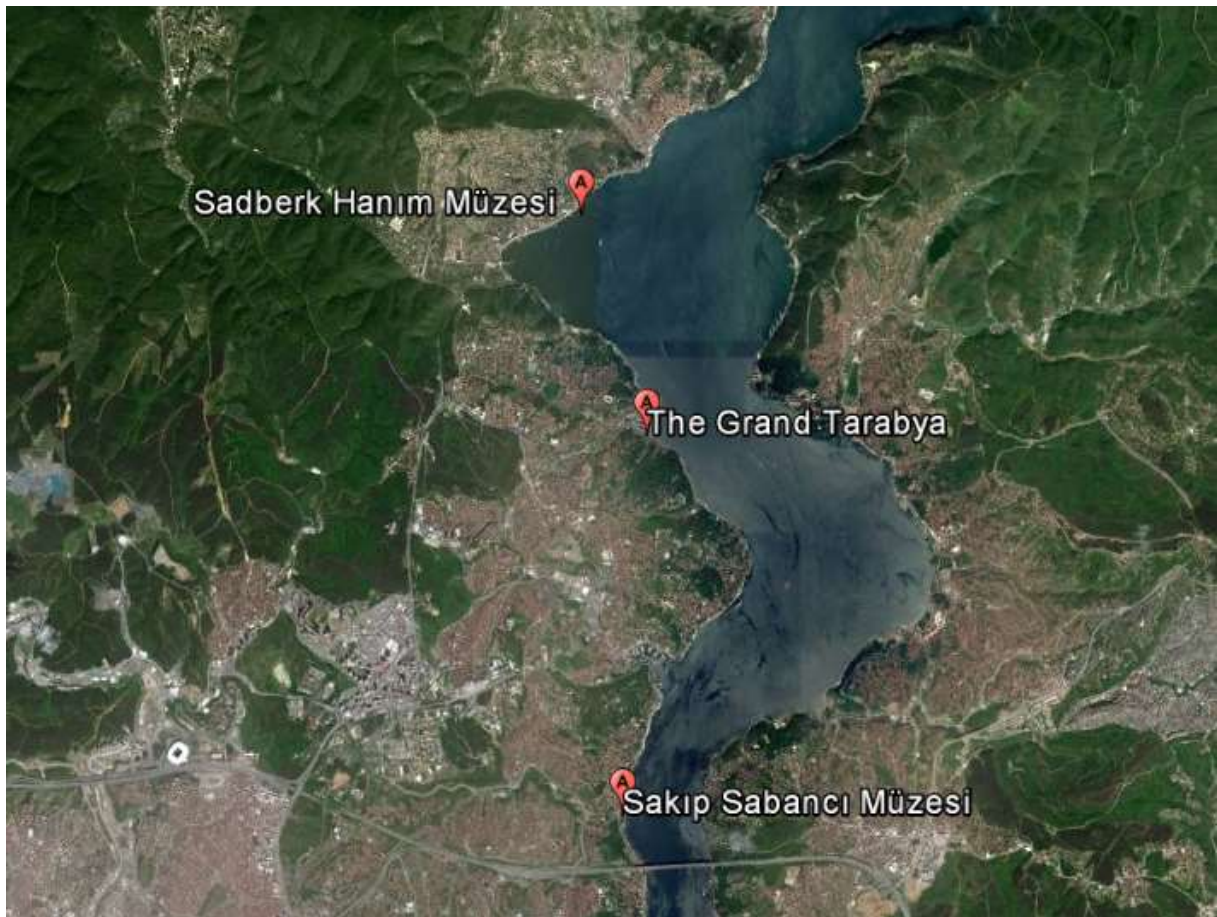
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Visit of Sabancı Museum is located at Emirgan one of the oldest settlements on the Bosphorus . Today presents a versatile museological environment with its rich permanent collection

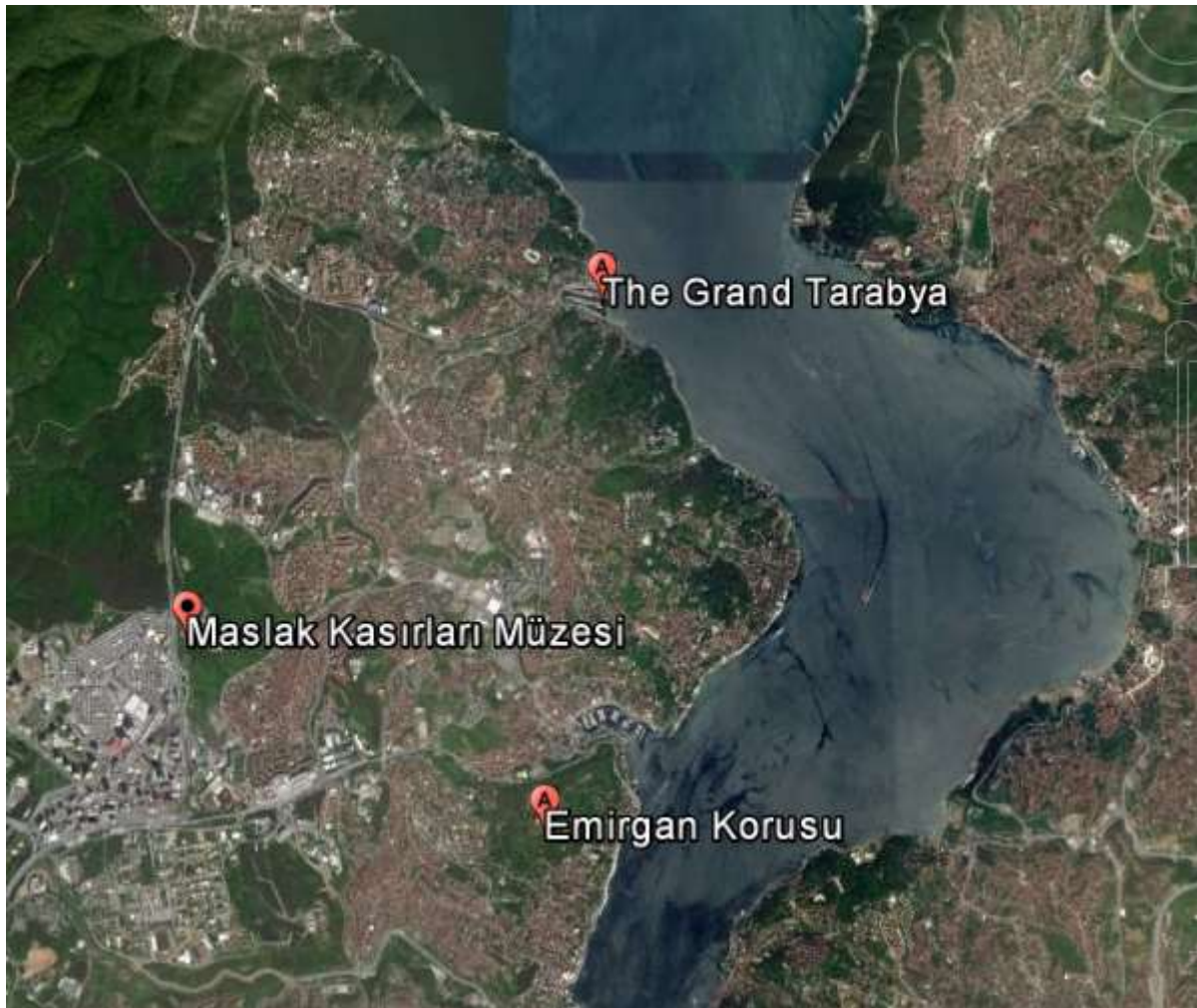
Tour 3 Gardens of Sarıyer

Tour 4 Villages Of Northen Bosphorus

Sarıyer's Bosphorus villages, backed by steep hills, were once rural fishing communities. They later became retreats for the city's wealthy. In the Ottoman period the sultans came to these villages for picnics and excursions. Many foreign embassies built summer residences in this period. Since the construction of the coast road, these villages, and increasingly the hillsides behind them, house many expensive villas owned by İstanbul's rich businessmen, actors and musicians, attracted by the coastline and the lush forest behind.

We will continue than to Rumeli kavak . This picturesque little town is intimately connected to the sea, with boats, fishermen and fish restaurants dominating life and commerce, and is almost completely skipped by tourists.
